Clergy Delegate Process

According to the *2016 Book of Discipline* ¶135: "The clergy delegates to the General Conference and to the jurisdictional or central conference shall be elected from the clergy members in full connection and shall be elected by the clergy members of the annual conference or provisional annual conference who are deacons and elders in full connection, associate members, and those provisional members who have completed all of their educational requirements and local pastors who have completed course of study or an M. Div. degree and have served a minimum of two consecutive years under appointment immediately preceding the election."

This means all Tennessee Conference ordained elders and deacons in full connection are eligible to be elected as delegates to General and Jurisdictional Conference. Those clergy who feel a calling and desire to serve as a clergy delegate and who are willing to make the commitment to serve on the Tennessee Conference delegation are encouraged to fill out this nomination form to help other clergy learn more about them.

Clergy Nomination Process

Each clergy should submit her/his nomination using the Clergy Delegate Nomination Form. **The Fillable PDF is preferred** but you can also submit your responses with a Microsoft Word Document. All information must be provided as requested on the form.

Email a high-resolution JPG photo of the nominee (or indicate if a photo of the nominee is in the 2016 Annual Conference Photo Directory) with the submission of this form **no later than April 3, 2019**, to delegate.nomination@tnumc.org. The Conference Secretary will confirm receipt by email. If you do not receive a confirmation, please follow up with Monica.Mowdy@tnumc.org.
