

Resolution for Current Appointments of Officers, Agencies, Boards, and Other Offices
Continue through December 31, 2021

Whereas: The unification of the Memphis and Tennessee conferences to be named the Tennessee-Western Kentucky Conference was anticipated to be effective January 1, 2021.

Whereas: In the anticipation of that effective union, all appointments of officers, representatives to boards, agencies, and other offices of the Tennessee Conference were approved to continue serving through December 31, 2020.

Whereas: The current pandemic led to the postponement of the 2020 Southeast Jurisdiction Conference thus delaying the approval and formation of the Tennessee-Western Kentucky Conference beginning January 1, 2021.

Therefore be it resolved, that the current officers, representatives to boards, agencies, and other offices of the Tennessee Conference that would have expired December 31, 2020, shall continue through the end of the calendar year 2021, so that their expiration will coincide with the effective creation of the Tennessee-Western Kentucky Conference, January 1, 2022.

Be it further resolved, that any person desiring to step down from their current position as an officer, a representative to a board, agency, or other office shall be granted the opportunity to do so.
